United Way is proud to announce that we have reached the 75% mark of our \$2.5 million goal for the annual community campaign. Funds raised during the campaign are invested in 57 programs run by 43 nonprofits in Ottawa County.

United Way also develops partnerships between existing agencies, launches new initiatives to address unmet needs, and collaborates with agencies, organizations, business leaders and community stakeholders to identify and address ways to help all people in Ottawa County to reach their full potential. The campaign wraps up on March 23 at the annual Celebration event.

2016-2017 Campaign Chairs P.J. and Kristen Thompson are encouraged by the generosity of our community so far during this year's campaign.

Kristen said, "We are thankful for the generous support of United Way in Ottawa County. United Way touches the lives of 1 in 4 people in our community, creating widespread and positive change in the lives of people all around us, including our families, friends and neighbors."
